FRUIT CRUSHER

Please ensure that you have received all the items listed below:

- Crusher body (1).
- Hopper (1).
- Hand crank (1).





Before Using

- Assemble the crank unit, as per picture. First put nut then screw handle then with a wrench (3/4" or #19) tight the nut to the handle.



- Please check unit, and make sure rollers are moving freely. If not, check troubleshooting section
- Sanitize unit prior to use it

Important Precautions

- 1. Keep hands and loose articles away from rollers and gears at all times.
- 2. Keep unit away from children.
- 3. Do not immerse unit in water.
- 4. Do not store in direct sun.
- 5. Never dismantle unit.
- 6. Hand crank only.
- 7. Thoroughly wash crusher when finished using, store crusher indoors if possible.

<u>Maintenance</u>

- 1. Clean unit after each use.
- 2. After using it, store unit in a dry place,
- 3. From time to time hand-tighten the screws of the unit.
- 4. After each use. Lubricate outside of unit with household oil (WD-40 or similar). See pictures for places that require lubricant. Do not lubricate rollers themselves.





TROUBLESHOOTING

- Rollers hit one another when crushing, and the unit stops working. Please check video on our website on how to fix this. <u>http://www.thevintageshop.ca/allproducts/fruitcrusheroi.html</u>
- 2. To back up the unit when crushing, you will need a wrench $(3/4" \text{ or } \#_{19})$. Back up the unit from the nut (The handle will unthread from shaft if you back up using it).
