Items Needed:

- -PET Carboy with a 1" hole.
- -The Vintage Shop Spigot or Easy On/Off Spigot.
- -The Vintage Shop Spigot Wrench

nstallin<mark>g Spigo</mark>t:



- Place PET carboy with <mark>ho</mark>le side facing up.
- Place nut into the Spigot Wrench.
- -Pla<mark>ce spigot</mark> body i<mark>nto the</mark> hole of the carboy, making sure that the o-ring is on the outside of the Carboy.
- -Insert Spigo<mark>t Wrench with</mark> the nut into the neck of the

carboy, and reach to the threads on the Spigot.

- -Start turning the spigot body clockwise to screw the nut on. You do not need to turn the
- nut at all. -Once the nut is snug tight, check if the spout is in the desired position. If yes remove the tool from the carboy and test with water for leaks.

If the spout of the spigot is not in the desired position:



- -Turn spigot counter clockwise to loosen the nut a little bit but still keeping it attached.
- Remove the tool from the nut. -Rotate Sp<mark>igot and</mark> nut coun<mark>ter clockwis</mark>e at approximately the same angle that the spout was off from the vertical position.
- <mark>-Once you turn t</mark>he spigot to the rig<mark>ht position,</mark> attach the Spigot Wrench to the n<mark>ut</mark> and re-
- <mark>-Tighten the spigot</mark> by han<mark>d and</mark> Spigot Wrench only.

Fill up Carboy with water and test for leaks
